All Newspaper Staff members are first of all, reporters. There are different types of reporting for different sections. Reporters are the heart of the newspaper. Without reporters, there is no newspaper. While reporters may have the title of a certain area e.g. Sport, they may be asked from time to time to cover a breaking news story in a different area.

#### **Editor-in-Chief**

This position shall be filled by a staff member who has demonstrated the following qualities:

- strong leadership
- strong writing and editing skills
- ability to set and meet deadlines
- strong oral communication skills
- strong organizational skills
- solid understanding of layout design

#### **The Editor-in-chief**

- ⇒ Supervises all section editors and their staff
- ⇒ Conducts all budget, planning and staff meetings
- ⇒ Enforces deadlines and meeting attendance
- ⇒ Delegates responsibilities and sees that tasks are completed
- ⇒ Proofreads all pages before they are sent to the printer
- ⇒ Writes a column occasionally
- ⇒ Leads staff by: thinking creatively with story assignments and projects; praising and motivating frequently; criticizing gently and respectfully; guiding by example in writing and managing

#### **Assistant Editors x 4**

Qualities similar to Editor-in-chief. Must display ability to work in a team and under pressure.

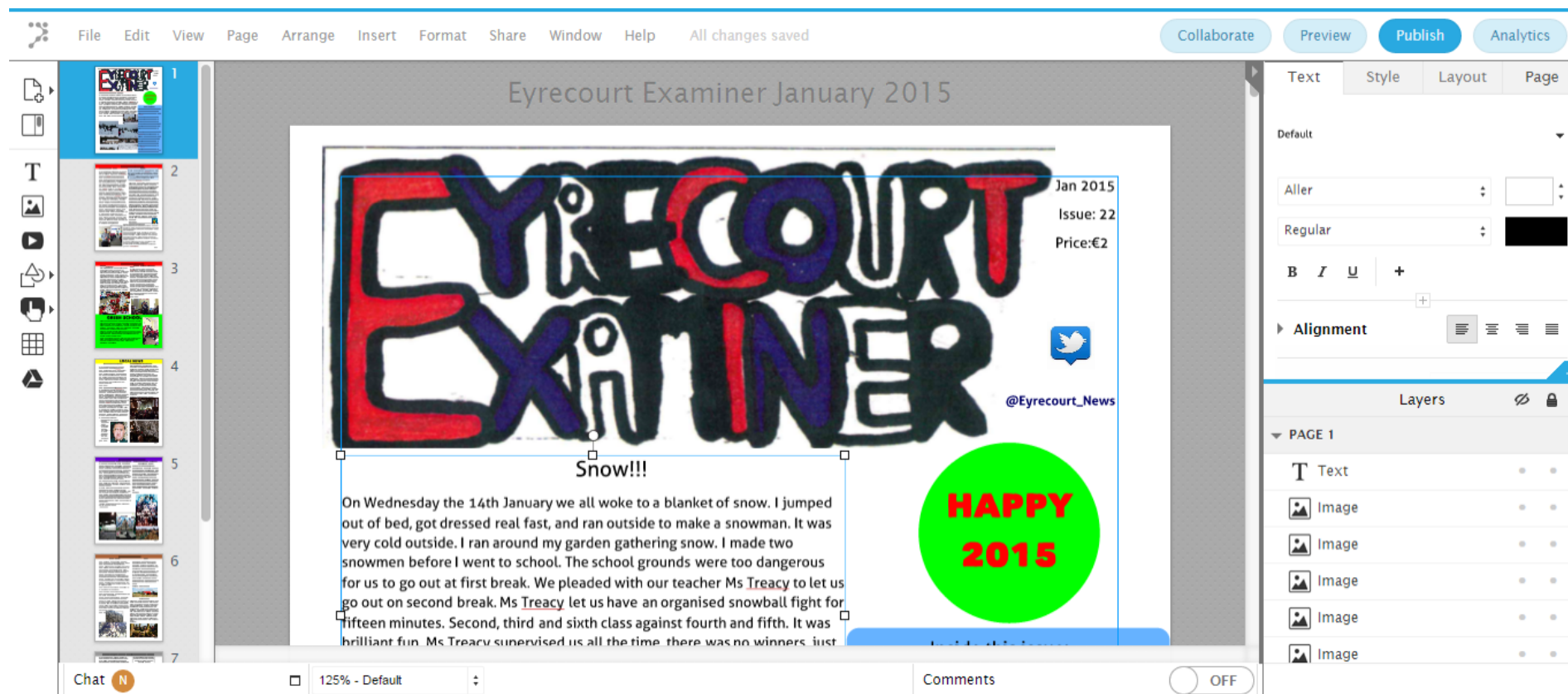

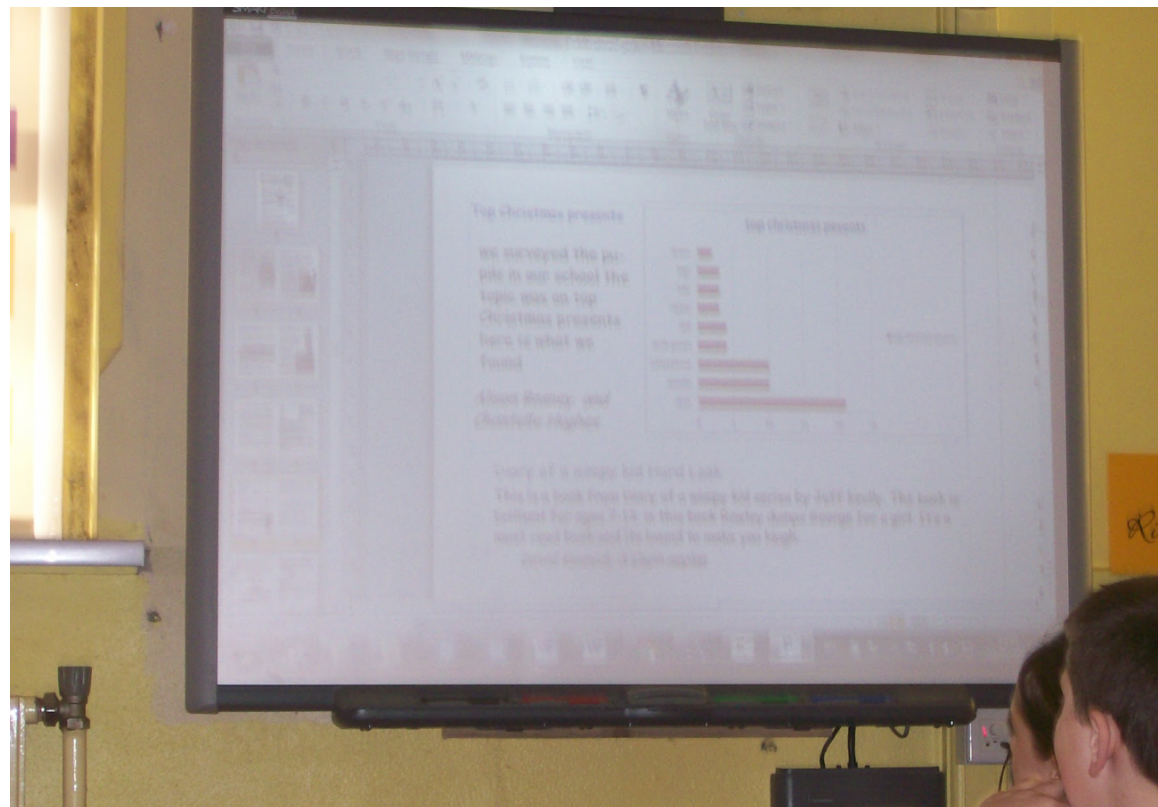

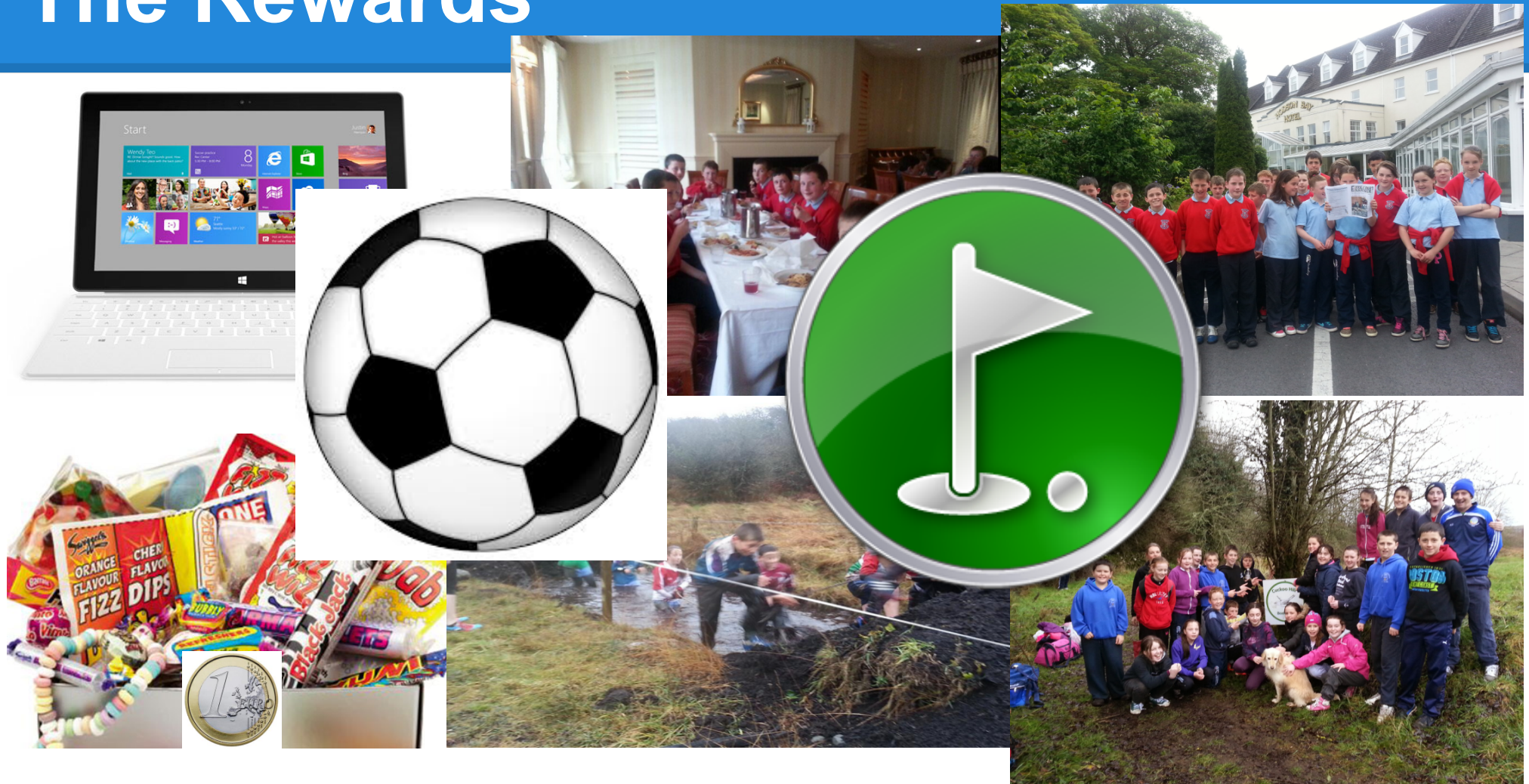
The Muck Run is back this year. It is on at 12 noon on St. Stephens Day.
